# Finland's President Sauli Niinistö phoned to President Vladimir Putin in view of formerly applying at NATO on May 18

Heads of the two counties had a sincere exchange of views over the announced decision by Finland's leadership to apply for NATO membership.

<u>Vladimir Putin stressed</u> that rejecting the traditional policy of military neutrality would be wrong since <u>there are no threats to Finland's security</u>.

<u>Such a change</u> in the country's foreign policy course <u>could have a negative effect</u> on Russia-Finland relations, which have been built over the course of many years in the spirit of neighbourliness and partnership cooperation.

The Presidents also discussed the situation in Ukraine. In particular, Vladimir Putin shared his opinion of the state of the <u>negotiating process between Russian and</u> <u>Ukrainian</u> representatives. This process <u>has been practically put on hold by Kiev</u>, which does not show any interest in a serious and constructive dialogue.

## On inhumane treatment of civilians by Kiev – Russian MoD

**In Nikolaev**, in and around schools No 7, 15 and 35, and in Kramatorsk of the Donetsk People's Republic in schools No 5, 6 and 9, fighters of Ukrainian armed formations have equipped firing positions, deployed armoured vehicles, artillery and MLRS, and are forcibly holding residents of nearby houses in the basements

**In Novgorodskoe** of the Donetsk People's Republic, AFU units equipped stronghold in Petrovskaya Gora residential area and school No 16 and placed heavy weapons and ammunition storage. However, no civilians were evacuated;

**In Severodonetsk**, Lugansk People's Republic, artillery and multiple rocket launchers have been deployed by the Ukrainian armed forces on the territory of a chemical plant in close proximity to densely populated residential areas.

The militants, knowing that the **victims** of such criminal actions **would be civilians**, deliberately target Russian Armed Forces positions from residential areas, provoking them to return fire in order to subsequently place responsibility for the destruction of civilian infrastructure and possible civilian casualties on Russian servicemen, and **spread fakes about alleged "Russian atrocities"** through Western media and on various Internet sites.

Such actions by Kiev once again demonstrate an inhuman attitude towards the fate of its own citizens and show a complete disregard for all norms of morality and international humanitarian law. Meanwhile, the countries of the collective West prefer to cynically "turn a blind eye" to the numerous war crimes committed by the Kiev regime.

Russia's Permanent Representative to the UNO Vasily Nebenzya cited geography and history schoolbooks from Ukraine during a session of the UN Security

Council on Thursday, to demonstrate how the Kiev government was twisting and rewriting the country's history.

"History and geography curricula were modified the most. I have here with me an 8th grade Geography schoolbook edited by P.Maslyak and S.Kapirulina. According to it," the predecessors of the French, Spanish, Portugese, Turks, and even Jews came from Ukraine," he said.
